COURSE DESCRIPTION (OVERVIEW):

This class will meet on Wednesdays 4:00- 5:30pm starting on January 28th, 2026. In this class we will learn to create Kawaii art, a style developed by Japanese artists in the 1990s. It is characterized by big eyes, bright colors, and simple designs. We will learn to use soft lines and rounded shapes to create cute characters. The idea behind kawaii drawing originally was and still is to simply make people smile and feel happy. Students will be separated into groups by age and/or skill level if needed.

SYLLABUS/OUTLINE: WEFKLY BREAKDOWN OF PROJECT-BASED LEARNING LAB ACTIVITIES:

Each week students will be given prompts to create different characters and imagery using techniques learned in class. Students will be challenged with new projects based on individual skill levels and experience. Projects will be different each semester to allow returning students to continue.

COURSE OBJECTIVES AND APPROXIMATE TARGET DATES:

By the end of the semester, students should have all projects complete. There will be an optional gallery in the Spring that students may participate in.

STUDENT ASSESSMENT - what will be used to evaluate student progress and/or end of semester pass/fail status?

- 1) Student agrees to attend at least 80% of class sessions/lessons offered. Attendance is kept online and tracked by Partnership staff. Failure to meet 80% or be on track to meet 80% may result in program discontinuation.
