COURSE DESCRIPTION (OVERVIEW):

Masterclass meets Tuesdays 5:30-7:00pm beginning JAnuary 27, 2026.

This class may focus on projects in several styles chosen by teacher and students together (Realism, animated, impressionism, abstract, etc) The goal is for students to grow in the area of art they already love while the teacher chooses some projects and new mediums to challenge students to grow and try new techniques. Often, students in this class are able to focus and learn quickly which allows us to create large scale projects that can take several weeks to complete. It is common for students to only complete one or two large projects throughout the semester, especially when we focus on light, depth, and proportions in more realistic styles. There will be a snack provided during each class.

SYLLABUS/OUTLINE: WEEKLY BREAKDOWN OF PROJECT-BASED LEARNING LAB ACTIVITIES:

(This class has flexible project timelines that will be tailored to fit the needs of each class. New projects/prompts will be given each semester to accommodate returning students and challenge them to try new techniques according to individual skill levels.)

COURSE OBJECTIVES AND APPROXIMATE TARGET DATES:

By the end of the semester, students should have all projects completed displaying techniques learned in class.

STUDENT ASSESSMENT - what will be used to evaluate student progress and/or end of semester pass/fail status?

- 1) Student agrees to attend at least 80% of class sessions/lessons offered. Attendance is kept online and tracked by Partnership staff. Failure to meet 80% or be on track to meet 80% may result in program discontinuation.
