| Week 2  | Learning about the different native American dwellings. Creating a chalk picture of a Pueblo Village and painting cloth like a Sioux tipi.  |
| Week 3  | Making our own watercolor painting inspired by Lisa A. Fifield painting “Native Women, Native Clay” from the Oneida tribe.  |
| Week 4  | Learning about the different symbols used by native American, and using them to make our own mask with papier mâché. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Making the mask.</li></ul> |
| Week 5  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Painting the mask and adding decorations.</li></ul>   |
| Week 6  | Choose a design to make Nearika painting with yarn  |
| Week 7  | Learning about what is a storyteller doll.<br>Pottery: making a storyteller with clay.  |
| Week 8  | Pottery: using hand building techniques to make a water jug.<br>Looking at different pattern used to decorate pottery in different tribes and choosing one to draw on our water jug.    |
| Week 9  | Painting our water jug.<br>Learning about Native American Pictographs to use them for painting our own rocks.   |
