# COURSE DESCRIPTION (OVERVIEW):

Students will explore the art of creating with flat glass. Students will learn glass cutting and shaping skills to create art in two very different art glass techniques: Fused Glass and Stained Glass.

Fused Glass: A brief introduction to kiln schedules will be followed by hands-on exploration of various techniques in glass fusing. Students will complete several projects including a coaster, nightlight or suncatcher, and a piece of garden art or a plate/tray/bowl.

Stained Glass: Students will learn to prepare and cut a pattern, foil the glass pieces, and solder, patina and polish to create a beautiful stained glass piece of art using the copper foil method of stained glass.

**Week 1 - Fused Glass -**Intro to tools and practice cutting,shaping, and grinding flat glass. Create small project like coaster or nightlight

**Week 2 -** Expand on previous weeks lesson to design and create larger project (Pick up completed projects on 4th week of class.)

**Week 3 - Stained Glass** - Refresh on tools/ learn techniques to cut on different textured glass, pick from some designs or bring your own basic design.

**Week 4 - Stained GLass-** Finish cutting and grinding (if you have any left) and foil wrap. Discuss Solder and new tools then complete your stained glass window. <u>All project will go home</u> today
