Gina Edwards has been working as a glass artist for over 20 years, and has been a Fused Glass and Bead Making instructor at Water Street Glassworks for 13 years.

COURSE DESCRIPTION (OVERVIEW): This dynamic four-week class

is designed to introduce novice students to the art of marble making in soft glass. Students will design and create marbles with use of a propane & oxygen torch. Students will learn design techniques, color application and sculpting to form glass into various size marbles. Each class session is tailored to the skill level of the students. NO EXPERIENCE NECESSARY.

SYLLABUS/OUTLINE: WEEKLY BREAKDOWN OF PROJECT-BASED LEARNING LAB ACTIVITIES

Describe activities that will reinforce the lesson. Include anywork and time to be required outside of

class:

Week 1 – Safety precautions, lecture on glass properties, learn tool use, marble making terminology, and annealing process. Marble making demonstration with single color application followed by student torch time for practicing basic shaping techniques, cold connections, removing and fire polishing marbles. Proper annealing placement.

Week 2 - Review of the class and work from previous week. Demonstration of multi-color twist applications.

Student torch time to practice new techniques.

Week 3 - Review of the class and work from previous week. Demonstration of implosion technique. Student torch time for practice new and old technique

Week 4 - Review of the class and work from previous week. Demonstration of advanced implosion and how to turn marble into pendant. Student torch time for practice.

COURSE OBJECTIVES AND APPROXIMATE TARGET DATES:

Steps to check for student understanding, along with dates or # of weeks into class: Instructors will observe students while working and offer additional instruction to ensure the student is retaining information/lesson.
