## COURSE OBJECTIVES AND APPROXIMATE TARGET DATES:

Students will do 2 lessons per week. Each lesson will consist of a short video where the teacher shares the key concepts for the lesson. Students will then play a song and play games to reinforce their learning. Students will turn in screenshots of completed activities in Google Classroom each week from September 18- December 4, 2023 and again from February 5-April 22, 2023.

STUDENT ASSESSMENT - what will be used to evaluate student progress and/or end of semester pass/fail status?

All classes abide by the following:

- 1) Student agrees to attend at least 80% of class sessions/lessons offered. Attendance is kept online and tracked by Partnership staff. Failure to meet 80% or be on track to meet 80% may result in program discontinuation.
- 2) The Partnership Student Assessment or Performance Form is filled out by the teacher and turned in to Partnership staff. The link to this form is found on the web page for this class. Failing marks for lack of participation, behavior issues, practice time, etc. may result in program discontinuation.

Class-specific assessment: Students will turn in screenshots of completed activities in Google Classroom each week from September 18- December 4, 2023 and again from February 5-April 22, 2023.

ADDITIONAL RESOURCES: (online, books, video, etc.): Students will have access to the online program Piano Prodigy. A keyboard will be purchased for them. They will need access to the internet and a computer with Windows 8/10 or macOS 10.13 or greater.
