COURSE DESCRIPTION (OVERVIEW): This is for students who have passed 1-2 Learn to Skate USA levels only and are making the transition to hockey. In Hockey, students will be on the ice 2-3 times each week (this includes practices and in house scrimmages). Hockey students will learn the

fundamentals of skating, stick handling, and shooting in a fun, engaging learning environment. Equipment can be rented and USA hockey membership is required (an additional \$55 fee). Enrollment in this class is for Winter and Spring 2024 hockey classes. 1-2 weekday evening practices and a weekend scrimmage. The number of ice touches is dependent on age.

COURSE OBJECTIVES AND APPROXIMATE TARGET DATES: Students should gain at least 3 of the skills involved in each Hockey Learn to Skate USA level. To show mastery, students should pass at least one hockey level as identified by Learn to Skate USA curriculum.

Steps to check for student understanding, along with dates or # of weeks into class: Students will be assessed on ice every 6-7 weeks by their respective instructor to gauge if a student has passed their level.

STUDENT ASSESSMENT - what will be used to evaluate student progress and/or end of semester pass/fail status?

- 1) Student agrees to attend at least 80% of class sessions/lessons offered. Attendance is kept online and tracked by Partnership staff. Failure to meet 80% or be on track to meet 80% may result in program discontinuation.
- 2) The Partnership Student Assessment or Performance Form is filled out by the teacher and turned in to Partnership staff. The link to this form is found on the web page for this class. Failing marks for lack of participation, behavior issues, practice time, etc. may result in program discontinuation.
